## **INDIAN DIPLOMA IN CRITICAL CARE MEDICINE ( IDCCM )**

### 01. Introduction

IDCCM aims at improving the quality of doctors working in the Critical Care department. In the present era of scientific and technological advancement, doctors also need to update their knowledge and skill so as to provide cost effective quality care to patients in different specialty areas. IDCCM has been planned in order to prepare the qualified doctors to function effectively in all adult intensive care units.

### 02. Goal

The goal of the critical care diploma programme is to provide specialized training in critical care departments which can provide tertiary level care to produce competency in various fields of management of the critically ill. Over a stipulated period of one year these specialists should be capable of providing high quality care in tertiary care centers. They shall recognize the health needs of the community and carry out professional obligations ethically and in keeping with the objectives of the Health Policy.

### 03. Objectives

After completing the IDCCM course the trainee should be able to:

- Provide intensive care of high standard to the critically ill adult patients using advanced therapeutic and supportive modalities and skills.
  
- Implement a comprehensive follow up and early intervention for the “At Risk” patients

- Seek and analyze new literature and information in Critical care and practice evidence based medicine
- Demonstrate adequate managerial skills.
- Work as a productive member of the interdisciplinary team consisting of doctors, nurses and grass root functionaries providing care to the critically ill.

#### 04. Syllabus

The Syllabus of course content, teaching, learning methods and activities of the programme are designed keeping in mind the guidelines issued by Indian Society of Critical care medicine.

- The candidate must have gained experience in the diagnosis and treatment of patients with serious medical and surgical disease including coronary artery disease and neurosurgical disease.
- During the training the candidate must gain knowledge in two aspects - The knowledge about pathophysiology, diagnosis and treatment of a series of disease processes and skills of specific procedures and interventions that the candidate must be able to perform.

#### 5. Exams

- Eligibility for appearing in Exam of IDCCM
  - Candidate are eligible to appear for the IDCCM exam after satisfactory completion of the specified training period in a recognized center for the IDCCM
- In-training assessment of candidates
  - Candidates are assessed at monthly intervals by the teacher for progress towards appropriate goals
  - The CoBaFolio competencies record book should be maintained by IDCCM candidates under the supervision of their teachers that will track the attainment of specified competencies in critical care.
- Mandatory requirements to be completed prior to exam
  - Certificate from the teacher/institute stating satisfactory completion of training. This training should include attendance at workshops including ACLS, hemodynamic monitoring & mechanical ventilation, review courses etc.
  - CoBaFolio competencies record should be duly filled.
- Written exam
  - The written exam for the IDCCM will be held every year in March and in July (Center may vary)

- It consists of multiple choice questions.
- Oral exam
  - The oral exam is conducted by a panel of four examiners over one day and includes
    - Two typical ICU cases scenarios (each case scenario by two examiners) on which questions will be asked by the examiners.
    - Table viva on ACLS proficiency and airway skills
    - Table viva on interpretation of ECG's, lab reports, X rays, CT scans.
    - Table viva on setting up of a ventilator, setting up of hemodynamic monitoring like central line/arterial line/Swan Ganz insertion skills and bedside monitoring of a critically ill patient.
    - Table viva on commonly used drugs.

All exam results will be sent to the candidates & displayed on the website in about one month after the exam. Candidates who pass the exam will receive the certificate by post.

#### 06. Seats

The total intake for IDCCM approved by ISCCM in our institute is two per year

#### 07. Duration

Duration of the Indian Diploma in Critical Care Medicine (IDCCM) is one year for MD/MS/DNB candidates.

#### 08. Academic Eligibility

MD Medicine/ Chest/ Anesthesia/ Emergency Medicine  
 DNB Medicine/ Chest/ Anesthesia/ Emergency Medicine

The base qualifications must be from a MCI recognized university.  
 In case of any doubt/controversy regarding the eligibility, the course coordinator should be consulted. Decisions by the ISCCM executive committee in this regard will be final & binding.

**Institute accreditation criteria:** All institutes accredited for IDCCM from the date of approval.

#### 09. How to Apply

The applicant shall download the application form together with the prospectus. The completed application form should be sent to The **Admission Office, Jubilee Mission Medical College Hospital, Jubilee Mission P.O., Thrissur East-680 005**. OR the same may be directly handed over to the **Office Superintendent, Jubilee Mission Medical College & Research Institute, Thrissur**. The following self-attested documents should be enclosed with the application form. A D/D for Rs. 1500.00 in favor of The Director, Jubilee Mission Hospital payable at Thrissur towards the cost of admission process should also be enclosed.

## 10. Documents to be submitted along with the application

Applicant shall submit, along with their application, two passport size photo and self-attested photocopies of the following documents:

1. Identity and address proof ( Passport/Aadhar card/ Driving license)
2. PAN card
3. MBBS degree certificate
4. MBBS registration certificate
5. Post graduate degree certificate – If recently finished , an undertaking from the student to provide the same on the interview day
6. Post Graduate Registration certificate – If recently finished , an undertaking from the student to provide the same on the interview day
7. Course and conduct certificate from the institution last held
8. Experience certificate in critical care, if any

Applications submitted should be complete in all respects. Late or incomplete applications or those not accompanied by relevant documents will stand rejected without further intimation.

Candidates are instructed not to enclose any original certificates along with the application.

## 11. Last Date of Application

The completed application forms along with relevant enclosures should reach The Admission Office, Jubilee Mission Medical College Hospital, Jubilee Mission P.O., East Fort, Thrissur-680 005 on or before **10<sup>th</sup> January** for the January Session and on or before **10<sup>th</sup> July** for the July Session.

Completed Applications can be submitted by Regd. Post/Speed Post with A/D, so as to reach the office before the last date notified for the receipt of the same. The college will not be responsible for any delayed delivery.

## 12. Selection Criteria

The selection of the eligible candidate will be based on the marks obtained in the

qualifying exam and/or interview held.

### 13. Admission

An interview will be conducted to select the appropriate candidate. Selected candidates are required to complete the admission formalities within the specified date. They should, at the time of admission, bring the original documents mentioned in Section 10 for verification.

### 14. Fees to be remitted at the time of admission

Tuition Fee to the Institution for the entire course : Nil

If a student discontinues the course after the commencement of the course, they are required to repay the stipend already received, if any.

### 15. Monthly Stipend

Selected candidates will be paid a monthly stipend of *Rs.63,000/-*(Rupees Sixty three thousand only )

### 16. Registration

After selection, the candidate must register himself/herself with ISCCM by filling Student Registration form accompanied with a fee of *Rs. 14160/-* which includes the registration & examination fee for the first attempt. Once selected, it is mandatory for the candidate to become ISCCM life member.

Registration form and fee (demand draft/at par cheque favoring “Indian Society of Critical Care Medicine - College” payable at Mumbai) should be sent to the ISCCM secretary at the Mumbai ISCCM secretariat address at the time of registering for the course.

### 17. Minimum Requirement for Council Examination

The students should have a minimum of 80% of attendance during the

course for successful completion. They are entitled to take twelve casual leave and twelve Special Conference leave per year.

#### 18. Code of Conduct

Every student is required to adhere strictly to the code of conduct of the college and hospital.

#### 19. Preventive measures against ragging

According to the Kerala prohibition of ragging disorderly conduct to a student of an educational institution, which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raising apprehension or embarrassment to that student and includes teasing, or abusing or playing practical jokes or causing hurt to such students or asking a student to do any act or to perform something which such student will not in ordinary course be willing to do.

The Act makes ragging an offense. The punishment is imprisonment for a term up to two years and a fine up to ten thousand rupees to those convicted of committing, participating in, abetting or propagating ragging within or outside any educational institution.

The Act mandates dismissal of any student convicted under it from educational institutions. Such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a term of three years from the date of order of such dismissal.

On receipt of a complaint of ragging, the Head of Educational Institution can suspend the accused student and is duty bound to enquire into the matter within seven days.
